UK CENSUS RECORDS BY DAVID MOWBRAY

These are collected in the folder "David UK CENSUS" and are listed by county. Rather than list all of the files here, suffice it to say that each county is simply

abbreviated, such as "BDF" = Bedford. These abbreviations are known as the Chapman Codes and can be de-coded using the Parish Locator program (see "David' s Notes").

David' s files combine the data for Donegal, Londonderry and Tyrone, which are the only Irish counties where any of us have Mowbray records.

There is a file of all the persons recorded together with their parents, linked marriage details and linked death details.

There are also marriage and death records that are unlinked, i.e. "strays." So, David put together a file for each category. They also include the linked entries.

Explanations: The code in the marriage file is the surname code.

ZZ = Mowbray F = Moubray

The source codes are:

J = Mowbray Journal

I = IGI

P = Parish Register

L = Information from correspondence.

G = General Registration index.
